### Summer

- "Where Everybody Belongs" (WEB) Orientation
  - Middle School Transition Program for 6th graders
  - Days Before School Begins (expect Mon, Aug 14)
  - Introduced to 8th grade WEB leader
  - Become familiar with school campus before school begins
  - Year-long program
    - Will follow up with 6th graders on a regular basis
    - Social events
